

REMEMBRANCE RUN 2022

August 13-14, 2022

From Delmar Stevens: "When my grandpa (Togo) Frank Quinn was 8 yrs old, he was taken from his Yerington Paiute family, by the government and forced to become a resident at the Stewart Indian School in Carson City, Nevada. He rebelled. He ran, trekking 50 miles to return home to his people. And the government came again. And Frank ran home. Three times. Frank was taken, and three times he escaped, till they finally stopped chasing him. Delmar's son Kutoven has been running since he was 4 years old, and in 2021, upon hearing of the 215 graves at the Kamloops school in Canada, he decided to run in Frank's footsteps, and the first Remembrance Run was born. This year Ku runs from Yerington back to Stewart, to hear from representatives about the progress of the government investigation into boarding school sites in the US. He invites you to join him.

The Stevens family invites you to the Remembrance Run, a 50 mile journey from the Yerington Paiute Reservation to the Stewart Indian Museum, to honor the children who survived Indian boarding schools and to remember those who never came home.

We welcome your stories at the mountain camp, very aware that remembering and speaking of these experiences is difficult. For the good of all, we ask that the event begin and end with peace. Like last year, we have approved specific media reps to join us, and SCHH Productions is returning this year to continue filming for the documentary, "Remaining Native."

Some run with Ku, some walk. Some complete the entire odyssey; others give what endurance they can. It's not a competitive race. 4WD vehicles can follow along. The conditions are primitive, no services. Participants will need to bring their own support crew, camping equipment, food and drinks. No pets, livestock, or fires.

Remembrance Run 2 is funded by a Dreamstarter grant, awarded to Ku in partnership with Sierra Endurance Sports, by Running Strong for American Indian Youth. Thank you Billy and Pat Mills for your generous support! Stewart Indian Museum and the Nevada Indian Commission are hosting the gathering at journeys end. - * As technology improves, so do we. 3-D technology offers greater accuracy in mammography screening.
- Women 40 and over require NO referral. Women 39 and under, or men, MUST present a physician (PCP) referral.
- Must be at least 366 days since last screening.
- NO minors can be left unattended and they may NOT accompany you into the exam room.
- Results are mailed directly to you and your PCP / Specialist.

Please be sure you have all of the following with you upon arrival to ensure a smooth check in experience:

- Current and valid government-issued photo ID
- Current insurance card (if applicable)
- Mammography Patient Registration forms - please complete before your appointment (forms are available online at nvhealthcenters.org/ mammography)
- Name and phone number of your Primary Care Physician (PCP)

Acceptable Methods of Payment:

- Call your insurance company to find out if 3-D is covered. If it is not covered, you have the option of purchasing this enhanced test at a cost of \$50.
- Medicare Medicaid Sliding Fee Scale
- Women's Health Connection (WHC)
- Most major insurances Yearly Preventive Screenings are covered under most insurances, however, verify your coverage prior to your appointment to assure the Mammovan is an accepted provider.
- Individuals NOT COVERED by health insurance may qualify for a "no charge" screening.








