TRIBAL ELECTION, SATUDAY, JUNE 24.2023

The Lovelock Paiute Tribe Council has called the 2023 Tribal Election to be held on Saturday, June 24 2023, Tribal administrative offices , lovelock, Nevada. The polls will be open at 7:00am and close at 7:00pm. After the polls are close, a count will be conducted and the unofficial results posted. The official certified results will be posted after the election process is completed and the Tribal Council approves the certification.

There are two tribal council vacancies on the ballot for 4 years term and all candidates have

to meet the requirements of article III (3) and article IV of the constitution; article IX, section 1,3,4, and 6 of the approved Election Ordinance. The Tribal Constitution and the Election Ordinance are the governing documents for the election. (position that are for election call for one member that reside on the colony and one (1) that does not reside on the colony.)

2023 Tribal Election dates to remember:

APRIL-21-2023- Post notice of election.

April- 25 2023 opening date for requesting absentee ballots

May- 9-2023 Opening date for the candidacy. eligible voter list 1st draft

May-15 2023 Opening date to request Advisory Question to be on the Ballot, and close may 2023.

May-23 2023 closing date for advisory question

JUNE-2-2023 Deadline for file for Candidacy

JUNE-5-2023 committee determines eligibility of candidates and recommends Tribal Council Approval


JUNE 9-2023 end of day deadline for absentee ballot requests

JUNE-16-2023 Post list of eligible candidates- absentee ballots mailed

JUNE-23-2023 Deadline for receiving absentee ballots (COB-POST OFFICE)

June-27 2023 deadline for election challenges

NOTICE

FOR ELECTION, POLLING PLACE, AND ABSENTEE BALLOTS

1. The Lovelock Paiute Tribal Council has called the CY2023 Tribal Election for Saturday June 24th, 2023. The Tribal Election will be held in accordance with the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws and Tribal Election Ordinance.
2. The polling place for the CY2023 tribal election shall be the Tribal Administration Building on the Lovelock Indian Colony. The polls shall open at 7:00am and close at 7:00pm.
3. Any qualified tribal voter can request for an absentee ballot if they may be absent from the Lovelock Colony due to the nature of his/her employment, business, health, physical disability, education, or, in the branch of military service. The request must state the eligible voter requesting the absentee ballot; signed, dated and notarized; include current mailing address. The deadline for submitting requests for absentee ballots is close of business, June 9th, 2023.
